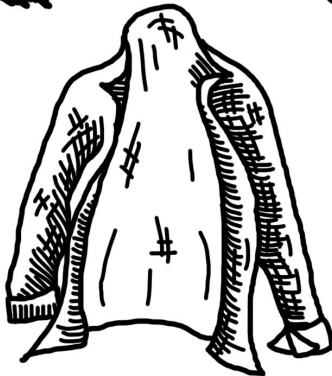


# ROBERT BADEN-POWELL'S RECIPE No. 1: BREAD



SPREAD YOUR COAT ON

THE INSIDE UPPERMOST\*

MAKE A PILE OF FLOUR,

MIDDLE TO MAKE A CUP



MIX WITH A PINCH OR TWO  
OF SALT AND BAKING POWDER

POUR IN HOT WATER



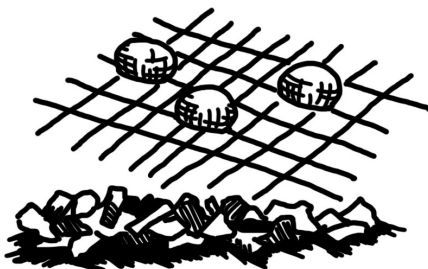
KNEAD AND MIX

PAT INTO BUN SHAPES



PUT ON A GRIDIRON  
OVER HOT ASHES

PILE ASHES ROUND AND  
LET IT BAKE ITSELF
